Sub: Permissions under Section 12 of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972.Reg.

Whereas, Section 12 of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972 empowers the Chief Wild Life Warden to grant permit for "hunting" for: (a) education; (b) Scientific research; (bb) Scientific management; (c) collection of specimens for recognized zoo or for museums and similar institutions; and (d) derivation, collection or preparation of snake venom for the manufacture of lifesaving drugs.

Whereas, in case the wild animal to be dealt is listed in Schedule-I of the Act, prior permission of Central Government is required.

Whereas, the State Chief Wild Life Wardens have been forwarding proposals to the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, seeking approval of Central Government for a wide range of activities like capture of wild animals, radio-collaring of animals, collection of blood, tissue samples, translocation etc. for the purpose of scientific research and/or wildlife management.

Whereas, the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change had prepared a format for forwarding application to the Central Government under Section 12 of the Act. This format was forwarded by the Ministry to the Chief Wild Life Wardens of all States/Union Territories vide letter of even no. dated $25^{\text {th }}$ May 2023 for inviting comments.

Whereas, the matter and the format was considered by the Standing Committee of National Board for Wild Life in its $73^{\text {rd }}$ meeting held on $17^{\text {th }}$ July 2023 under the chairmanship of Hon'ble Minister of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, and was recommended.

And now, therefore, in exercise of powers conferred with the Central Government under Section 62B of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972, it is directed that, henceforth proposals for seeking permission of the Central Government for hunting of wild animals under Section 12 of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972, be submitted in the format as annexed to this letter.

Also, no applications/proposals under Section 12, that are not submitted as per the said format, shall be considered in the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change.
