Whereas the area specified below is considered by the State Government to be of adequate Zoological, faunal, floral, geomorphological, natural and ecological significance for the purpose of protecting, propagating and developing wildlife and its environment.

Whereas Collector of District Hoshiarpur have issued proclamation under section 21 of Wildlife (Protection) Act 1972 for inviting claims, if any, in sanctuary Area falling in his jurisdiction.

Whereas claims to rights in sanctuary area have been settled by the Collector Hoshiarpur as required under the Wild Life Act 1972.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub section 26-A of Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972 (Amended upto 1993) and in continuation of Punjab Government Forests Department Notification No. 34(32)-92-FT IV/2040 dated 16.2.93, the Governor of Punjab is pleased to declare the area specified below to be a wildlife sanctuary for the purpose of protecting, propagating and developing wildlife and its environment from the date of issue of the notification in the official Gazette.
