WHEREAS vide Notification No. 34/2/2018-FT-5/1192195/1 dated 21.3.2018, the Government of Punjab constituted the "Punjab State Wetlands Authority" to function as an Apex Body to bring about an integrated management of wetlands in the State.

AND WHEREAS one of the provisions contained in Para (III) of Punjab State Wetlands Authority, Authority is required to constitute a Technical Committee to review brief documents, management plans and advise on any technical matter referred by the Wetland Authority.

NOW THEREFORE, the State Government hereby constitute a "Technical Committee" with following composition: -

The mandate of the Technical Committee will be as follows:

1. The Technical Committee will review brief documents and Management Plans of wetlands.
2. The Technical Committee will also review all the existing wetlands as well as make efforts to identify new wetlands.
3. The Technical Committee will also act as Grievance Committee.

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4. The Technical Committee will also hear any other technical matter which will be referred by Punjab State Wetlands Authority.
5. The Technical Committee will meet once in every three months and will present its progress in the subsequent meeting of Punjab State Wetlands Authority.
6. The Technical Committee will be competent to co-opt any other expert in its composition.
7. This Notification shall come into force from the date of its publication.
