The Committee shall render advice on measures to be taken for better conservation and management of the Sanctuary including participation of the people living within and around the sanctuary.

The Committee shall regulate its own procedure including quorum.

The ex-officio members mentioned at Sr. No. 5 and 6 shall be nominated only for two years.

No TA/DA shall be paid to the members of this Committee for performing their duties as members.

The Committee shall meet at least once in a three months and submit the report to Chief Wildlife Warden, Punjab.
